

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Director's Note



The musical *Cinderella* changed the course of my life. Dramatic but true. During my senior year of high school we did R & H's *Cinderella*. I auditioned for the show and received the privilege of playing the role of *Cinderella* herself! It was my first lead role in a theatrical production and the first time in my life that I truly believed that I could do anything I put my heart into. The theater was where I belonged. I then went to school for theater and here we are, full circle to the exact spot it all began.

As we dove into the score, there were marvelous rediscoveries of musical nuances and motifs. Rodgers & Hammerstein create intricate melodies that live in your head and spark your imagination with beautiful pictures and visions of nostalgia. This has been the beauty and the challenge of this show. The expectation of a familiar story while discovering it in a new way.

As we dove deeper into the script, studying this version of the story, a big element that stuck out was the emphasis on the political atmosphere that exists in this world. It struck parallels to the political climate of the 1970's. The free love movement, liberation, equality: all ideas and messages born in and around this era. This inspired much of the creative design of the show– blending real world 70's influences into a magical fantasy world. Our characters' journeys focus on the agency they possess but haven't quite found. We follow Ella, Prince Topher, and the entire ensemble as they discover themselves, take hold of their situations and create the lives they wish for. They exist in a world celebrating individuality, seeing the beauty of authenticity, reflected in all the forms it takes.

This cast, crew, and production team truly gave into this concept. Welcoming it with open arms and a head full of creative ideas. And, wow, did they deliver. This group of artists is immeasurable in kindness, community and collaboration. They truly have created an incredible experience and showed that anything is possible if we just believe in ourselves and treat one another with kindness and respect.

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
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ATLANTIC CITY BOYS THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2022
