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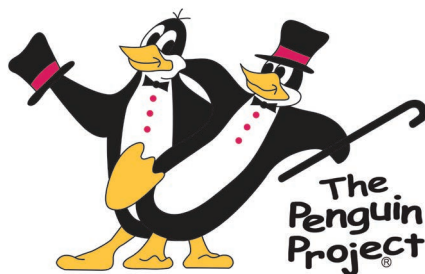


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Meet The Artists

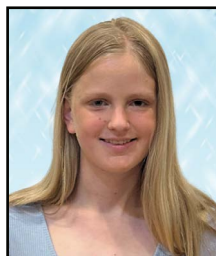
Grace Kreun / *Queen Iduna, Snow Chorus*
