

Directors' Note



"Well... that's theatre. That's life." And for forty-three consecutive seasons, it has also been Sioux Falls. Since 1982, Noises Off has returned every year, making it (as far as we know) the longest-running theatrical tradition in the city's history. Sardines, boxes, doors, faint despair...you know the rest. Every year, a rotating cast of local actors steps in — this year, Belinda, Brooke, Dotty, Garry, and the rest — Sioux Falls performers, every one of them. These are the people you're watching tonight. Special thanks to Dotty Otley (who has long played Vicki and is now playing Mrs. Crampnet) for the generous financial contribution so we can deliber this swan song. I'd be remissed if I didn't mention the generational contributions of the incomparable Lloy—

I feel it only fair to mention that the true heart of this evening lies in my production of Nothing On, a masterclass in comic precision, blocked to perfection since its premiere in 1982. The set —an exquisite hybrid of late-20th-century interior design and an authentically rendered 16th-century English mill—is a masterstroke still studied at Oxford and Cambridge...

My audience, my note, Lloyd! I (Jesse Jensen, NOT British) directed *Noises Off*, the play you're watching. Lloyd (British, insufferable) directed *Nothing On*, the farce I was forced contractually by Playhouse management to direct around.

I have long been a believer in collaboration, but the 1980s aesthetic, peeling paint, and misaligned doors belong in the Old Courthouse Museum, and Lloyd's directing choices belong in the Great Plains Zoo...

The cack-handed plonker of Noises Off resents my experience. My enduring success. My James Bondian appeal...

Lloyd's a philandering letch with all the warmth of Ebenezer Scrooge minus the redemption arc..

Strong words from a lad whose director's note contains three spelling errors and a coffee stain...

That was YOUR coffee, Lloyd!

Where was I? Right. The facts: *Noises Off* has been remounted in Sioux Falls every year since 1982. The cast changes, but Lloyd and his ancient companion Selsdon return without fail. (No one remembers why. Possibly an exchange program. Maybe witchcraft) Lloyd refuses to update *Nothing On*. Thus, the costumes, sardine plates, color palette, etc., remain frozen in time.

Superb dialect coaching, diletante.

We're in Sioux Falls, dick!

This is the final remount. Special thanks to DOGE for cutting its funding. Thank you for being here tonight. What you're about to see is *Noises Off! NOTHING ON!* Curtain, please!
