Director's Note



I am overjoyed that my fifth production as director for The Premiere Playhouse is the inspiring, complex, and ultimately life and loveaffirming classic of American musical theater, *Oklahomal* Set in the early 1900s in the Oklahoma Territory, our production tells the story of the cowboys and farmers, men, women, and children, as they navigate love, rivalry, and the pursuit of the American dream. As powerful and entertaining as this pursuit is in the musical *Oklahomal*, we must acknowledge that the real-life American settlers of the Oklahoma Territory, most of whom were of White European descent, pursued their dream at the expense and expulsion of the indigenous peoples and nations who had lived on this land for countless generations. While this musical doesn't tell their story, it is critically important that we remember and honor them.

Based on the play *Green Grow the Lilacs* by Lynn Riggs and originally premiering on Broadway in 1943, *Oklahoma!* was a groundbreaking production that revolutionized the musical theater landscape. With its integrated use of dance, music, dialogue and design elements all serving equal roles in the overall telling of the story, this first collaboration between composer Richard Rodgers and librettist Oscar Hammerstein III set a new standard for the genre and paved the way for future generations of musical theater creators. In our production, we aim to honor the legacy of *Oklahoma!* while exploring fresh interpretations of gender dynamics, musical expression and style, and visual design aesthetics that speak to the belief that the light and love of community ultimately overcomes the dark of mistrust and resentment.
